Targeted Case Management (TCM) is made available to all Individuals determined eligible for services according to the Kansas definition for someone with mental retardation or developmental disability. All individuals determined eligible may select a qualified licensed provider in the CDDO area to provide TCM service. The extent and frequency of services shall be determined by the individual served with the selected TCM provider. Providers are licensed by and registered with the Kansas Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services, Health Care Policy/Community Supports and Services.

A Case Manager helps in the planning and arranging of services, by doing:

Assessment: use of formal and informal ways to identify a person's service needs

Support Planning: working with a person, to develop a support plan outlining paid and unpaid services needed to live successfully in a community setting

Support Coordination: arranging for services in the plan, which can include finding the service, the funding and getting the identified services started.

Monitoring: making sure services meet a person's needs

Assistance with transition and portability: planning and arranging for services to follow the person when transitioning from school to adult services, when changing from one service to another, when moving from one provider to another, when moving to another community.

TCM Selection:

Signing this form indicates your selection of a Targeted Case Management provider to assist with development and implementation of your person centered support plan. You will be reminded of your options regarding Case Management at your annual BASIS Screening, and given another opportunity to select a provider. You may also contact your local CDDO or the Disability Planning Organization of Kansas, Inc. at any time to obtain information to select or change your Targeted Case Management provider.
